# Places in France with short trip by bus.

<u>le de France</u>: From Paris about 1 hour of bus driving to south-west direction.

At **St Quentin en Yvelines** nearby the city of Elancourt.

Trip themes: Farm works, French royal history, ponies' life.

Visits: Pedagogical farm, château de Versailles, Espace Rambouillet the park of forest's wildlife.

Sports: Sailing, riding.

**Normandie**: From Paris more than 3 hours of bus driving to the west direction.

At Asnelles, Bernières or Ver sur mer on seaside nearby the city of Caen.

Trip themes: Sea life and study of foreshore, Word war II, products from Normandy's farms.

Visits : Le Mont St Michel, Mémorial de Caen, Port en Bessin fishmen harbour, artisanal shortbread

manufacture, Isigny's cheese factory, oyster farms.

Sports: Sailing, sand yachting.

**Touraine**: From Paris less than 3 hours of bus driving to the south direction.

At **Chedigny** near the castle of Amboise in Loire Valley.

Trip themes: French royal history, sciences.

Visits: Amboise castle, Leonardo Vinci's Clos Lucé, Loches donjon, mini-châteaux park, houses cave.

Sports: Biking, trekking.

**Burgundy**: From Paris less than 3 hours of bus driving to south-east direction.

At **Gurgy** nearby the city of Auxerre.

Trip themes: Ponies' life, French Middle age history.

Visits: Medieval site of Guédelon castle, canal of Burgundy, Auxerre's cathedrale.

Sports: Riding, mini quad.

**Hauts-de-France**: From Paris less than 3 hours of bus driving to north-west direction.

At **Stella plage** nearby Le Touquet, seaside resort in the north of France.

Trip themes: Sea life and study of foreshore, ponies' life, protection of the environment and birds, renewable energy.

Visits: Nausicaa park of the sea, Marquenterre's natural reserve of birds, La Canche's bay, Maréis fishing centre.

Sports: Sailing, sand yachting, riding.

**Poitou**: From Paris more than 3 hours of bus driving to south-west direction.

At **St Cyr**, nearby the city of Poitiers.

Trip themes: Protection of the environment and birds, renewable energy, astronomy, multimedia audio-visual and 3D cinema techniques.

Visits: Futuroscope theme park, TOL windmill, show of birds of prey, Poitiers' planetarium.

**Sologne**: From Paris more than 3 hours of bus driving to south-east direction.

At **Salbris** or in the nearby city of **Romorantin**.

Trip theme: Forest's wildlife, astronomy, ponies' life.

Visits: Nancay's planetarium, goat cheese artisanal factory of St Aignan.

Sports: Canoeing, riding.

# Other places in France.

**Britany**: From Paris, 3 to 4 hours of TGV trains time and 1 hour maximum of bus transfer.

At Erquy, Dinard or Camaret sur mer on seaside along the Britany's coast.

Trip themes: Sea life and study of foreshore, traditional dance of Britany.

Visits : St Malo's aquarium, Oceanopolis Brest's aquarium, natural birds reserve of Cap Fréhel and

mussel farms.

Sports: Sailing, sand yachting, stand up paddle.

**Auvergne**: From Paris, 3 <sup>1/2</sup> hours of direct train and 1 hour of bus transfer.

At **St Sauves** or **Tauves**, in the hearth of the Chaîne des Puys, inactive volcanoes.

Trip theme: Geology.

Visits : Vulcania theme park, inactive crater of Lemptégy's volcano, top of Puy de Dôme, Volvic

source of mineral water, traditional cheese factory.

Sports: Climbing, private indoor swimming pool, orienteering.

**Lot et Garonne**: From Paris, 3  $^{1/2}$  hours of TGV trains time and 1  $^{1/2}$  hour of bus transfer.

At **Temple sur Lot** along the Lot river.

Trip themes: History of the Templars, Protection of the environment, renewable energy.

Visits: Castle of Bonaguil, medieval town of Penne d'Agennais, prune of Agen factory, Fontirou's

caves, Fumel hydroelectric power station. Sports: Canoeing, sailing, rowing, cycling.

**Alsace**: From Paris, 2 1/2 hours of direct train and 1 hour of bus transfer.

At Mittelwhir or Munster, same distance from Strasbourg and Mulhouse.

Trip theme: Heritage of Alsace, music.

Visits: Haut Koenigsbourg castle, European parliament, Tellure's silver mine, Hunawhir's stork

protection park, cheese factory of Munster, manufacture of pan spice.

Sports: Climbing, biking, orienteering.

**Provence**: From Paris, 3 hours of TGV trains time and 1 hour of bus transfer.

At **Bédoin** at the bottom of Mont Ventoux surrounded by Côtes du Rhône vineyards.

Trip themes: Wine making, geology.

Visits : Roussilon's quaries of ocher, distillery of lavender, candied fruits of Apt, châteauneuf du

pape wine cellars.

Sports: Caving, via-ferrata, cycling, orienteering.

**Savoie**: From Paris, 3 to 4 hours of TGV trains time and 1/2 hour maximum of bus transfer.

At **Sévrier** or **St Jeoire** on the shores of Annecy' lake.

Trip themes: Heritage of Savoie, traditional pastoral life.

Visits: Old town of Annecy, bell manufactoring plant, cheese dairy, cruise on the lake.

Sports: Sailing, canoeing, climbing, trekking, water skiing, stand up paddle.

Languedoc Roussillon: From Paris, 4 hours of TGV trains time and 1 hour of bus transfer.

At **Agde** along the mediteranean seaside.

Trip themes: Protection of birds.

Visits: Caves of Clamouse, medieval village of St Guilhem, cellars of Noilly Prat, mussel farms of the

Thau basin.

Sports: Sailing, wake-boarding.

**Ardèche**: From Paris, 3 hours of TGV trains time and 1 <sup>1/2</sup> hour of bus transfer.

At **Vogüé** along the Ardèche river.

Trip themes: Geology, prehistory.

Visits: Caverne du Pont d'Arc prehistoric site, Aven d'Orgnac geological cave, natural arche over the

river of Vallon Pont d'Arc, artisanal nougat factory.

Sports: Canoeing, caving, via-ferrata, trekking.

**Dordogne**: From Paris, 4 hours of direct trains time and 1 hour of bus transfer.

At Turenne, Figeac or Salignac-Eyvigues.

Trip themes: French medieval history, geology, prehistory.

Visits: Gouffre de Padirac, Pech Merle caves, Rocamadour sanctuary, Château de Castelnaud.

Sports: Canoeing, caving, climbing.

Winter sports: From Paris, 3 to 4 hours of TGV trains time and 1 hour maximum of bus transfer.

Alpine skiing or cross-country skiing or snowboarding with instructors from Ecole de Ski Française. Other snow activities: Dog sledding tour, ski joëring, snowshoes tour, ice skating or igloo's

construction.
- In Savoie and Haute-Savoie:

At Morzine or St Gervais, in chalets close to ski slopes.

At **St Jean de Sixt** or **Bramans**, in large chalets a few minutes by bus from ski slopes.

- In Auvergne:

At St Sauves, for beautiful cross-country skiing.

- In Switzerland:

At **Leysin**, international camp in the heart of the ski resort.
